Purpose:

The purpose of this document is to outline the qualifications and responsibilities of Firefighter with United Fire & Rescue District.

Scope:

This document applies to all members of United Fire & Rescue District.

Qualifications:

- Valid driver's license
- Successful completion of a background check
- Must be able to perform the role and responsibilities of firefighter
- Previous training and experience preferred but not required
- Must successfully complete, at the college level, Entry Level Firefighter (Parts A & B), Firefighter I, and Hazardous Materials Operations Level within one year of joining the District
- Encouraged to complete, at the college level, Firefighter II after completion of the probationary period
- To become a driver/pumper or driver/aerial operator, must successfully complete Entry Level Driver/Operator-Pumper or Driver/Operator-Aerial course
- Firefighters with less than 20 years with the District must meet the LOSA requirement or risk de-activation

Responsibilities

- Be a member in good standing with the District
- Have knowledge and understanding of the District's Policies and Suggested Operating Guidelines (SOG)
- Perform firefighting and rescue operations independently or as directed by an officer or incident commander by being aware of the potential safety and health hazards and using principles, tools and techniques as outlined in the District's Standard Operating Guidelines
- Assist with maintaining all equipment and apparatus within their station
- Report any equipment, apparatus or PPE deficiencies to an officer
- Fill out reports and inspections completely and accurately
- Attend District and station trainings and meetings
- Promote the District and their station in a positive manner
